DOT&PF is working with FEMA to administratively close out the completed emergency debris clean up projects along Front Street and Garteeni Highway.

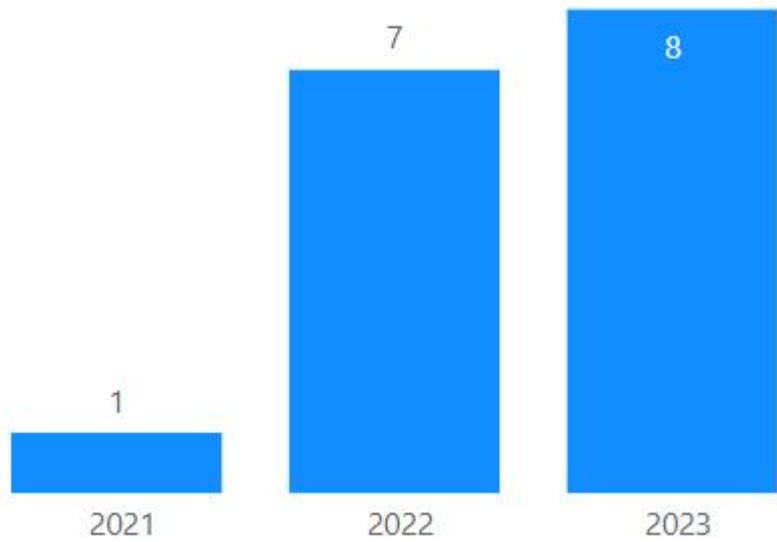
Design work will begin in late 2022 on two culverts located on Front Street milepost (MPt) 0.20 towards the ferry terminal and at Garteeni Highway MPt 0.65. While these two culverts will need further permanent repairs, their condition is stable, and they are functioning as intended.
